## Three college classes are offered at KHS; credits through Normandale Community College (NCC):

Introduction to Education	2 trimesters	4 college credits
Education Technology	1 trimester	3 college credits
Multicultural Education	1 trimester	3 college credits

Students transfer to NCC after graduating from KHS for the 2-year program; then transfer to Minnesota State University-Mankato for the final 2 years to earn a B.S. in Elementary Education. Note: the MSU classes are taught at NCC. These college classes are certified so that they are transferable to universities in the Minnesota State College System.
