OMS Snowriders 2024 - 2025

Snowriders is a ski and snowboard club for all OMS students. The purpose of the club is to introduce and provide an opportunity for students to learn and enjoy skiing and/or snowboarding. To accomplish this goal, we work with Hyland Ski and Snowboard Area (HSSA) to offer four different ski and snowboard lesson plans and lift ticket packages.

Lessons are offered for beginner, intermediate and advanced levels. Snowriders will be tested on the first week and placed in classes matched to their ability. Lessons run from 5:00 PM - 6:00 PM on Dec. 10 and Dec. 17. No refunds are given if you miss a lesson.

Rental equipment is available for both skiers and snowboarders. The cost of rental equipment is \$22 each week. Additionally, helmets are available for rental for \$9 each week. This fee is paid directly to ISD#271 (cash or check) each week and is not included in any of the Snowriders plans. Rental forms will be available at the Snowriders table Tuesday mornings. You are responsible for rental equipment. If you lose it, break it, steal it, or it is stolen, you will be billed to replace it.

Bus transportation is provided from Olson Middle School to Hyland (one way). Parents are responsible for transportation from Hyland to home. Students may stay at Hyland until close, but Snowriders advisors are available only until 6:30 PM.

Refunds will not be given for unused lift tickets or lessons.

Attendance during the school day is required on Snowrider days. If you're too sick for school, you're too sick for Snowriders. (exceptions are made for partial absence due to appointments)


