

# OMS Snowriders

## 2024 - 2025

Snowriders is a ski and snowboard club for all OMS students. The purpose of the club is to introduce and provide an opportunity for students to learn and enjoy skiing and/or snowboarding. To accomplish this goal, we work with Hyland Ski and Snowboard Area (HSSA) to offer four different ski and snowboard lesson plans and lift ticket packages.

### Snowrider Dates:

If Hyland and/or school is closed,  
a make-up date will be scheduled.

### **ALL plans include:**

- Membership in the club with advisor supervision until 6:30 PM;
- One way bus transportation from OMS to Hyland;
- Snacks.

Lessons are offered for beginner, intermediate and advanced levels. Snowriders will be tested on the first week and placed in classes matched to their ability. Lessons run from 5:00 PM - 6:00 PM on Dec. 10 and Dec. 17. No refunds are given if you miss a lesson.

Rental equipment is available for both skiers and snowboarders. The cost of rental equipment is \$22 each week. Additionally, helmets are available for rental for \$9 each week. This fee is paid directly to ISD#271 (cash or check) each week and is not included in any of the Snowriders plans. Rental forms will be available at the Snowriders table Tuesday mornings. You are responsible for rental equipment. If you lose it, break it, steal it, or it is stolen, you will be billed to replace it.

**Bus transportation** is provided from Olson Middle School to Hyland (one way). Parents are responsible for transportation from Hyland to home. Students may stay at Hyland until close, but Snowriders advisors are available only until 6:30 PM.

**Refunds** will not be given for unused lift tickets or lessons.

**Attendance** during the school day is required on Snowrider days. If you're too sick for school, you're too sick for Snowriders. (exceptions are made for partial absence due to appointments)

**Procedures on the day of Snowriders**

- ☐ Check in at the Snowriders table by the main office between 7:25 and 7:52 AM. You will receive a lift ticket OR a bus pass (depending on your plan). You must have your bus pass or lift ticket to board the bus after school.
  - ☐ If you forget or are late to school, you must check in with Mrs. Moen before 2:00 PM to pick up a bus pass or lift ticket. If you forget to check in, you may not be able to join us.
- ☐ Purchase a rental package (\$22 payable to ISD #271) (helmet is additional \$9).
- ☐ Purchase a lift ticket if you're on Plan D or have used up your prepaid tickets. (\$30 payable to ISD#271).
- ☐ Ski/snowboard equipment will be stored in the Peace Garden. Clothes and boots can be placed in a teacher's room or in your locker.
- ☐ At 2:37 PM, pick up your gear and load the bus outside the Pool Doors. Depending on the number of students each week, the bus may need to make 2 trips. When the bus is full, the remaining students will wait at OMS for the second trip.
- ☐ When you arrive at Hyland, you may need to
  - ☐ Take your rental form to the rental counter to pick up your equipment.
  - ☐ Meet Mrs. Moen in the chalet at 4:50 PM for lessons.
  - ☐ Meet in the chalet at 5:00 for yummy snacks.
- ☐ If an injury occurs or you have a problem:
  - ☐ Find a Snowriders advisor
  - ☐ Go to the Ski Patrol office and ask for help or ask them to page an Olson Snowriders advisor.
  - ☐ If you are injured, we will contact a parent and follow Ski Patrol recommendations.

# CODE OF CONDUCT FOR OLSON SNOWRIDERS

The following activities WILL NOT be accepted, tolerated, or overlooked at any Club activity:

A. Possession and/or use of cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, alcohol, or other illicit drugs. Furthermore you are not to be in the presence of anyone who might be using any of the above. If you are not actively removing yourself from the situation, you are a contributor and will also be guilty.

B. Destruction, injury, or misuse of any of any property or facility

1. Damaging any bathroom facility at any ski area.
2. Damaging someone else's equipment or person.
3. Writing on tables, bathroom walls, or school buses.

C. Stealing or other illegal conduct or any form of conduct that would reflect negatively upon the School District.

D. Abusive, negative, or any improper language, including swearing.

**PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT:** Suspension from the Club and any Club related activities for the remainder of the season with NO refund of any money. In addition, up to a two day suspension from school - at the discretion of Olson Administration Team.
